4. INSURANCE:

If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: "If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control".

10. MEASURMENT OF FLIGHT ALTLITUDE:

If necessary, the organizer can provide all participants with the electronic altimeter ADREL ALT-USB.

Every team shall submit, at registration, a deposit for each altimeter that will be issued. The deposit must be paid before the contest stars. The deposit shall be an amount of 50 Euro and shall be returned when the altimeters and batteries are returned. If an altimeter or battery is not returned, or is damaged, the deposit shall be retained. If all altimeters per team are lost, during a competition, a new deposit must be paid to allow the team to continue participating in the competition.

11. LIVE RESULTS:

During the competition the official championships website (www.spacemodels.pl) will be updated with the live results.

12. AWARDS:

The first three individuals in each class will receive FAI diplomas, FAI medals and organizer's cups and medals. The first three teams in each class will receive one FAI medal and all members, including team manager, will receive FAI diplomas and organizer's medals.

13. WORLD CHAMPIONS 2016:

The reigning World Champion 2016 has the right to participate in the next World Championships in that category, regardless of whether he qualifies for the national team or not.

FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, Volume CGR and Volume Space Models, Edition January 01,2018.

16. LICENCES:

Each competitor, team manager and team manager assistant must possess a FAI Sporting License, valid for 2018, issued by their NAC.

Organizers are required to use FAI Sporting License database for final verification the validity of sporting license of all team members.

17. AGE OF JUNORS:

A competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he attained the age of 18 (2000+).

18. OFICIAL LANGUAGE:

Polish and English.

19. CONTEST FEATURES AT CONTEST SITE:

Team will have a maintenance area equipped with tables and chairs. Flying site and all boxes will be guarded 24h.

20. ENTRY FEES:

350 euro basic entry fee for senior competitors, TM and TM assistant250 euro basic entry fee for junior competitors70 euro basic entry fee for official helpers and supporters35 euro entry fee for banquet

All fees must be delivered to the Organizers until April 30th, 2018. This also includes payment for lunches at airfield, camping, banquet etc. (acc. to Final Entry Form). For entry fees received later than April 30th, 2018 participants will pay an additional fee of 10%. The entry fees paid at the contest site will be increased by 20%. All fees must be paid in cash or by major credit card to the contest office.

21. PROTEST:

All protest must be written and presented to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 50 euro.
