2022 FAI F5B World Championship for Electric powered gliders, seniors, womens and juniors will be organised by the Bulgarian Aeromodelling Federation and Modelclub Ikar from 11-17 September 2022, Dupnitsa, Bulgaria.

Competition Rules

Class F5B seniors and juniors

European Championships will be run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 CIAM General Rules
- FAI Sporting Code Section 4,
 Aeromodelling Volume F5 Radio Control Electric Powered Model Aircraft, 2022
 Edition
- FAI Code of Ethics
- FAI anti-doping regulations

Valid FAI sporting licenses will be mandatory for each competitor, team manager. Only licenses which are registered on the FAI central database are valid.

The official languages is English and Bulgarian.


Visa requirements

Organisation

2022 FAI F5B World Championship for Electric powered gliders, seniors, womens and juniors, 12 - 18 September 2022, Dupnitsa, Bulgaria will be organised by Bulgarian Aeromodelling Federation, Modelclub Ikar Dupnitsa and Municipality Dupnitsa.

Location: Field near Dupnitsa town – 64 km south of Sofia, 42°17'48.62"N 23° 9'29.69"E



Transport: You can reach Dupnitsa:

- by car (highway from Sofia 65 km, 120 from Greece border);
- by train from Belgrade, Istanbul; Bucharest to Sofia then to Dupnitsa. Dupnitsa is on the railway from Sofia to Athens.
- by bus from Sofia central bus station every hour.
- by air to Sofia International Airport, then by car to Dupnitsa.

Visa

EU citizens not require visa when entering Bulgaria.

The daily flying schedule will begin at **09.00** and will continue through the various rounds till **18.00** The organiser reserves the right to change the daily schedule if necessary.

Classifications and awards

FAI medals and FAI diplomas for 1-2-3 individuals (seniors, female and juniors) and teams (3 seniors, 1 female and 1 juniors including the Team Manager) will be awarded. Additional organizer prizes will be awarded. In order to award the title of Junior World Champion, junior competitors from at least four nations must participate in the class. In order to award the title of Female World Champion, female competitors from at least four nations must participate in the class.

For the team ranking the best three results of the team (3 senior competitors, 1 Junior and 1 female) will be considered.

Puffin Models of Bristol Trophy for Individual winner, present holder: Gerben VAN BERKUM (NED)

Frequencies: 2.4 GHz

National teams and competitors

Each team may consist of:

- team manager
- 3 senior competitors
- 1 female competitor
- 1 junior competitor (age limit 18 years in 2022)
- official helpers and supporters

Weather

Continental climate without big contrasts.

Average temperature in September is 25 degrees.

Light wind north-west.

Sunrise: 7.00 - Sunset: 20:00

Entry fees

350 EUR for the team manager 350 EUR per adult male competitor 175 EUR per woman competitor 175 EUR junior competitor 60 EUR per helper, supporter

Deadlines

- 1. Intent to enter team with number of senior and junior competitors (Preliminary Entry Form): 28th February 2022
- 2. Official entry (Final Entry Form) including competitors names: 15 June 2022
- 3. Receipt of all entry fees: 15 June 2022

Entry fees submitted after 15 July 2022 +10 % penalty.

Any submitted after 15 August 2022 + 20 % penalty.

Entry fees will not be accepted on arrival.

Protest fees

All protests must be presented in writing to the contest director and must be accompanied by the deposit of a fee. The amount of this fee shall be 50 Euros. The deposit is returned only if the protest is upheld.

Lodging

There will be drinks, snacks and food available to purchase on the field all the days of the Championships.

Anti-doping

If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA

Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: "If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control".

COVID-19 Safety Information

COVID-19 Deadline

As it happened last year with all World or Continental Championships, as organizers we will be in direct contact with CIAM Bureau in order to evaluate together the situation and decide accordingly. As always public health is and will be our top priority.

The deadline to decide whether or not to continue the championship is the 11 July 2022.

Insurance

The Organiser will provide third party insurance cover to all participants for accidents involving injury to others or damage to property according to the host country's legislation. Participants should provide their own health insurance to cover accident and illness.
